Little Miss Dewie is a "duckumentary" that follows the true story of Mira Tweti, an investigative journalist, who found an orphaned duckling at a lagoon in Los Angeles. Tweti came to the duck's rescue, named her Dewie, and gave her a place to live until she was able to find a more suitable home. Tweti's articles have been featured in the *The Los Angeles Times*, *The New York Times* and *L.A. Weekly*. She is also the author of three books and directed and produced a

documentary called *Birds of a Feather*. G2 Gallery is a natural fit to present the heartwarming screener as it is dedicated to supporting the environment.
